### Download and install our app

Since the beginning of March, users of our training services registry have had access to the VR device application produced as part of the project!

The app includes training activities on a wide range of topics, covering areas such as 3D printing, computer graphics, and web development among others.

This approach was adopted considering the purpose of the application (demonstrating how VR can be used in training processes). The cross-sectional presentation through various thematic areas provides an idea of how VR technology can be used for training a broad range of skills. At the same time, it serves as proof of the versatility of the technology in educational applications.

The application is available for download to any user registered with the system and requires a VR kit - compatible with the application requirements - to run and use.

### We will visit MARR

The upcoming meeting of the project partners is one of the key events, within the framework of the activities planned for implementation. During the meeting, staff representatives from each of the consortium partners will go through intensive training in the use of VR tools and practical use of the registry's functionality. This training is the first stage of the deployment of the registry, with the ultimate goal of leading to its widespread exploitation.

In the next step (starting in May and over the next few months), trained partner representatives will use the skills they have acquired during the workshops they will implement for end-user groups.

The workshops will be the first organized deployment of the system to an end user, which will allow the collection of valuable feedback on the functionality of the system, and which to some extent, will act as UAT (User Acceptance Testing).

The meeting will be held at the headquarters of the Małopolska Agencja Rozwoju Regionalnego in Krakow.
